




The City of Orlando District 5 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precinct OL60.

Municipal precinct OL60 extends north of Split Willow Dr, Seaboard Rd and along Silver Star Road, east along John Young Parkway. The southern boundary is just north of State Road 408 and Amelia St. The western boundary is on the east side of Lake Lawne and parallel to Walkup Dr to the north. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando. This municipal precinct also includes the following Orange County precincts:

The polling place for OL60 is located at Northwest Community Center, 3955 WD Judge Dr.

Northwest Community Center is situated at the end of Kalwit Lane and the north side of WD Judge Dr in precinct OL60.

Each listed Orange County precinct is partially made up of the City of Orlando and partially unincorporated Orange County, which change according to municipal annexation ordinances.
