






The City of Orlando District 6 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precinct OL63.

Municipal precinct OL63 approximately extends north to Raleigh Street and Columbia Street, ends in the south at Chandler Street, and ends in the east at South John Young Parkway. The western boundary ends just west of Frazier Avenue. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando. This municipal precinct also includes the following Orange County precincts:

The polling place for OL63 is located at Dr. James R. Smith Neighborhood Center, 1723 Bruton Blvd.

Dr. James R. Smith Neighborhood Center is situated at the corner of Bruton Blvd and Well St in precinct OL63.

Each listed Orange County precinct is partially made up of the City of Orlando and partially unincorporated Orange County, which change according to municipal annexation ordinances.
