



State Senate (2022) district 10 falls within North Orange County. The northern boundary follows along Seminole/Orange County border. The western boundary zig zags down to Kennedy Boulevard and extends to a section of Interstate 4. The southern boundary runs parallel north to East Marks Street and just south of Lake Virginia. The eastern boundary follows along North Semoran Boulevard and extends to North Lakemont Avenue and the Seminole/Orange County border.
