

State Senate (2022) district 13 falls within Southwest Orange County. The northern boundary follows along Johns Lake and the Florida Turnpike. The western boundary follows along Lake/Orange County border. The southern boundary follows along Osceola/Orange County border. The eastern boundary follows along Interstate 4 and extends to Dr. Phillips Boulevard and South Hiawassee Road.
