

Orange County Supervisor of Elections Young Adult Focus Group

Purpose

- To provide input and recommendations on policies, programs, and initiatives designed to increase voter engagement, education, and turnout among young voters in Orange County.
- Advise the Supervisor of Elections on youth engagement strategies and outreach activities and develop new ideas for voter participation.
- Empower young voters to become active, informed participants in the democratic process.

Focus Areas

- Expand voter registration opportunities for young people.
- Increase awareness of election dates, procedures, and civic responsibilities.
- Design youth-focused educational campaigns and outreach events.

Term Length

- Board members will serve a minimum of one year.

Meeting Schedule

- The board will meet once per quarter, either in person at the Orange County Supervisor of Elections office or virtually.

Liaison Support

- Two members of the Supervisor of Elections staff will serve as board liaisons, providing guidance, resources, and coordination for board activities.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be between 18 and 26 years old.
- Be a current resident of Orange County.
- Interest in elections and community leadership.
- Able to attend quarterly meetings.
- Willingness to work in a team environment, share ideas, and participate actively in SOE projects.
- Uphold the nonpartisan mission of the SOE office.
- Represent the board in the community.
